PREFACE

At the publication of this second issue of "Immanuel", we want to express our gratitude to those who have encouraged us by their enthusiastic reception of the first issue, as well as those who have helped us by their constructive criticisms. Several correspondents suggested that, as the original Hebrew is not accessible to most of our readership, more extensive summaries would be appreciated, even if this should involve some reduction in the number of articles and books dealt with in each issue; we have tried to meet this wish. In response to a request for brief identifications of the authors whose works are discussed, a few words about the author are included at the end of each article.

We are happy to announce that a German edition of "Immanuel" is now appearing as a special section of the *Freiburger Rundbrief* (Editor: Dr. Gertrud Luckner). The character of this edition is somewhat different from the English one; the number of contributions is smaller, but in several cases full translations have been given.
